



Hike Mount Pemigewasset

Beginner Hike | 10 participants/hike

Mount Pemigewasset is an incredible beginner winter hike because it's at the foot of Franconia Notch State Park so often gets heavier snowfall than other more southern 'beginner' hikes, and because most of the hike is below treeline, there is less chance of significant ice and you are protected from the winter weather elements. It's a beautiful short hike and rewards you at the summit with spectacular western-facing views looking toward Mount Moosilauke and Vermont!


